Sex trafficking expert, researcher, and author Alexandra Lutnick will educate the legislative community about the realities of domestic minor sex trafficking. The domestic sex trafficking of minors is a problem of growing concern yet little critical attention. The lunch & learn offers a closer look at the minors who are currently in the sex trade - whether by choice, circumstance, or coercion - mapping the complex factors associated with young people's involvement in trading sex and the social connections that facilitate their behavior. Lutnick's research takes a hard look at how local and federal responses to trafficking increase young people's vulnerability to trading sex and encourages a holistic understanding of choice, force, third parties, our failing social safety net, and criminal justice strategies.
